2022 PATHWAYS TO PERFORMANCE PROGRAM

KEY INFORMATION

General Information

- The *Pathways to Performance Program* is an annual 36 session program divided into two terms, focussed on performance skills, stagecraft, teamwork, public performances and social health and wellbeing.
- Participation in the Blue Roo *Pathways to Performance Program* is open to participants of all abilities working together, highlighting individual performers' strengths.
- All Blue Roo facilitators, independent artists and directors have Government working with people with disability and working with children registrations and are COVID vaccinated.
- Each program session is three hours
- *Pathways to Performance Program* sessions and scheduled rehearsals are held at the Communitify Paddington Hall, 10 Moreton St, Paddington on Thursdays afternoons from 12.30 pm to 3.30 pm.

Fees Information

- The first *Pathways to Performance Program* session is free for new people interested in Blue Roo
- The program meets the requirements for NDIS core support funding for NDIS participants
- Program fees are \$19/hour x per 3 hour session (GST free) or \$ 20.90 x per 3 hour session (including GST) + a single \$50 non-refundable annual public performance fee. Fees are billed in advance for every 9 sessions in each 18 session Term.
- Blue Roo *Pathways to Performance Program* sessions are based on 1:3 or 1:4 NDIS support ratios (standard support). Participants needing a higher level of support (high intensity support) will organise their own additional support.
- Participants organise their own travel arrangements for program sessions.
